

# Spring Lodge no. 1174 Gus Bayer Scholarship

*An academic scholarship in the amount of \$4,000 to be disbursed in \$500 increments at the outset of each quarter or semester until the life of the scholarship is completed*

## Minimum Qualifications:

1. Student must have graduated from or be a senior in a high school system and reside in a Spring, TX zip code OR be the direct offspring, grand-child, step-child, or legal dependant of a member of Spring Masonic Lodge no. 1174, A.F.A.M.
2. Student must be 19 years of age or younger on August 1<sup>st</sup> of the application year.
3. Applicant must be an American citizen and must be willing and able to provide proof of their citizenship.
4. A copy of the student's academic transcript (high school suffices for the application, followed by collegiate thereafter) reflecting a minimum GPA of 3.3 on a 4.0 scale (B+ or comparable ranking on other systems). Trade or Vocational school enrollment does not qualify for this scholarship.
5. A PROPERLY executed scholarship application postmarked between April 1<sup>st</sup> and April 15<sup>th</sup> of the current year.
6. Include two (2) letters of recommendation as follows:
  - A. One letter of recommendation from a non-school-related adult who personally knows the student (e.g., minister, employer, scout leader)
  - B. One from a teacher of whom the applicant was (is) a student.
7. Copies of student's applicable SAT, ACT, and other standardized test scores (Minimums – SAT: 1000 on old system; ACT: 22).
8. Student must be enrolled or planning to enroll in an accredited *Texas public college or university* for the current or subsequent term. Student must be willing and able to produce proof of enrollment and matriculation into the school.
9. All requested documents **MUST** be submitted in **ONE ENVELOPE** before the application will be considered.

The scholarship will be awarded in a nondiscriminatory manner without regard to an applicant's race, creed, color, gender, age (within the aforementioned age limit), national origin, ancestry, physical or mental disability, veteran status, or organizational affiliation.
